



ROTORUA DISTRICT COMMUNITY AWARDS

Thursday 29 April 2010

Council has available a number of community awards for which nomination and selection will generally take place once a year. Objectives and guidelines for the awards are described below:

Objectives

- (a) To recognise outstanding community service.
- (b) To recognise national and international achievements by local people.

Guidelines

- (a) Candidates must have contributed outstanding service in the Rotorua community. Candidates will either have contributed in a variety of areas over a long period (15 year guideline) or made a significant difference in a particular field; and/or
- (b) Awards will be presented to candidates living in the Rotorua District who achieve national representation in their respective fields; and/or
- (c) Awards may be presented to individuals or groups who achieve international recognition in their respective fields; and/or
- (d) Awards may be presented to candidates not currently living in the Rotorua District but who have previously lived in the district for a minimum period of 10 years consecutively and otherwise qualify under (a) (b) or (c) above.

Final determination of any award shall be at the discretion of the Mayor.

Presentation

Awards will be presented at a mayoral reception held for the purpose; whilst the Mayor retains the discretion to present an award at any other suitable occasion.
