Project Overview: Widening of Lake Road to four lanes to improve safety and reduce congestion.

What's Happening Now:

- Tree removal and site clearing work
- Driving piles for the new Utuhina Stream Bridge
- Laying new ducts for Telecommunications and Power

What Will happen Over the Coming Month & Onwards:

- Continuation of work on the new Utuhina Stream Bridge.
- Continuation of laying service ducts.
- Commencement of stormwater drain laying.

Traffic Management:

- Regular information on coming works and timelines in 2011 will be provided by email updates, electronic message signs and on www.rdc.govt.nz in 2011/2012.
- Some delays can be expected in the coming week around the Ranolf st/Lake rd intersection while stormwater drains are laid across the road. Stop/Go will be operating with a stopping time of no longer than 5 minutes.
