

## Lake Road Four Laning

Project Update # 8

27 January 2012

**Project Overview:** Widening of Lake Road to four lanes to improve safety and reduce congestion.

### What's Happening Now:

- Laying Telecommunications and Power ducts on both sides of the road.
- Continuation of piling for the new Utohina Stream Bridge.
- Pavement and Drainage work at the new Dinsdale St and Railway Rd entrances.

### What will happen Over the Coming Month & Onwards:

- Continuation of work on the new Utohina Stream Bridge, stormwater drain laying and laying of service ducts.
- Preparation for the removal of the Railway over bridge including work in Karenga Park.
- Works are generally on the south side between Dinsdale St and Ranolf Street.

### Traffic Management:

- Regular information on coming works and timelines in 2012 will be provided by email updates, electronic message signs and on [www.rdc.govt.nz](http://www.rdc.govt.nz) in 2012.
- The road will narrow through the Utohina Stream Bridge over the coming weeks as new bridge piling gets closer to the existing road. Speed restrictions and stop/go will be used accordingly.
